

Circular Walks From Frost Folly

To the Church

Approx. distance 2km 1¼ miles. Suitable for wheel chairs, buggies & prams.

Leave the car park by the gate in the south east corner and follow the farm track downhill through the zig zag and on the upward slope turn right through the kissing gate into St. Katherines Drive. At the junction with Church Lane turn right. You can explore the Church which dates from the 11th Century (leaflet is available from the Parish Office) or continue down Church Lane to the next junction. Turn right into Westhatch Lane and after a few yards right again into Wellers Lane. Carry on up the hill to Frost Folly on your right.

Goughs Barn Lane

Approx. distance 2½ miles, 4km. Suitable for buggies. Possible for wheel chairs & push chairs but Hazelwood Lane section will be a strenuous push and may have muddy sections.

Leave the car park by the main gate, turn right and at the junction bear left following the Ramblers Route sign. You are in Bowyers Lane. Follow the road downhill past the side of Moss End Garden Centre and cross straight over the main road into Buckle Lane. Carry on downhill and take the first turning to the right. This is Tickleback Row. Follow the road uphill to its junction with the A3095 opposite the Old Leathern Bottle pub. By all means stop for a 'quickie', but if you don't, turn left and follow the pavement till you're opposite the turning into Jealotts Hill Research Station – Syngenta. Turn left into Goughs Barn Lane and follow this byway to its junction with Hazelwood Lane. Turn left along Hazelwood Lane and take the first turning to the left into Buckle Lane. Follow Buckle Lane back across the A3905 into Bowyers Lane and back to Frost Folly car park.

Hawthorndale Lane

Approx. distance just less than 3 miles, 4.5kms.

Leave the car park by the main gate, turn right and follow Wellers Lane keeping right at the junction with Bowyers Lane. Continue past Drowned Boy pond and keep along the road until you meet Penfurzen Lane on your left. Turn into Penfurzen Lane and follow it to the A330. Do not cross the road but turn sharp left into Hawthorndale Lane. This is a new bridleway created in 2006 as a joint venture between the Parish Council, the Borough Council and Syngenta. Follow the bridleway for its full length and exit out into the Syngenta service road. (If you want a longer walk turn right, cross the A3095 and follow the Goughs Barn Lane instructions). Keep straight on past the New Leathern Bottle pub and then cross the road into Tickleback Row. Follow this quiet tarmac road to its junction with Buckle Lane. Turn left and follow Buckle Lane back to the Maidenhead Road (A3095) at the side of the Shepherds House pub. Cross over the main road into Bowyers Lane and back to the car park.
