

Circular Walks From Frost Folly



4 of 5

Nuptown

Approx. distance 6¼ kms, 4 miles. This walk has long stretches of field paths with many stiles and is not suitable for push chairs or for the less agile.

Leave the car park by the pedestrian gate and follow the track to the church. Turn left into Church Lane and just after the vicarage turn right over a stile and follow the footpath down over the Cut and on to the road at Wane Bridge. Turn left and after a few yards take the footpath to your right. Follow this path across the fields.

Nuptown continued . . .

Away on your right will be glimpses of Hayley Green Farm, possibly the oldest dwelling in Warfield and originally the old moated manor house. Much of the moat is still intact. Eventually you will emerge on the road at Brockhill. Turn left and soon after the entrance to Planners Farm, take the footpath sign to your left. Follow the path until you reach the Ascot Road (A330). Cross straight over into Garsons Lane. Follow this quiet narrow road to its junction with Bishops Lane, just past Whitelocks Farm and Livery Stables. Turn left and on the right you are likely to catch sight of wild boar as they 'graze' in the field. Just past Hogoak Lane on your right the road bears left into Nuptown Lane, you want to carry straight on along the unmade byway of Hawthorn Lane. Walk the entire length of Hawthorn Lane and eventually you will get back to the Ascot Road at Hawthorn Hill. Cross straight over into Penfurzen Lane and when you reach the next tarmac road turn right into Wellers lane and return to the car park via Drowned Boy pond.

The Full Circuit

Approx. distance 10 kms, 6 miles. This walk is an extension of the Nuptown walk and the same reservations apply.

Follow the route for the Nuptown walk to the junction of Hawthorn Lane & the Ascot Road (A330). Having crossed over the road go right into Hawthorndale Lane then follow the footpath sign to your left. Follow the bridleway to the permitted path on your right. Go through the gateway cross the A3095 with care and enter Pendrys Lane. Follow this leafy lane downhill to its junction with Hazelwood Lane at the Westly Mill ford. Linger at this delightful spot and with luck you'll catch a glimpse of a kingfisher. When you are rested turn left down Hazelwood Lane, past the mobile home encampment, past the bottom of Goughs Barn Lane until you reach the junction with Buckle Lane. Turn left and follow Buckle Lane up to the Shepherds House pub. Cross straight over the main road into Bowyers Lane and so back to Wellers Lane & the car park.
